PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLE ZONE

The Lewisham (Prescribed Routes) (No. -) Traffic Order 202*

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lewisham propose to make the above-mentioned Order under the powers of sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Order would be to continue to ban motor vehicles from entering the length of Prince Street that lies between the New King Street and Watergate Street; or entering the length of Scawen Road that lies between Sir Francis Drake Primary School and Grinstead Road. This would be achieved by continuing the prohibited motor vehicle zones in those lengths of Prince Street and Scawen Road.

3. The Order is necessary to continue to promote a pleasant environment that feels safer in the immediate vicinity of a school, to discourage travelling to school by car in cases where alternative means of travel are available, and to encourage walking, scooting and cycling to school, thereby achieving positive health outcomes for the school community.

Any objection may be communicated to other persons who may be affected.
