- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the
- above named, Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.

 2. The purpose of the Order is to allow telecom works to take place at
- Heybridge Avenue.

 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
- Ine effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 entering or exiting Heybridge Avenue from A23 Streatham High
 - Road;
 (2) stopping in the Parking Bay on the side of No. 325 Streatham High
 Road
 - The Order will be effective at certain times between 26th July 2021 and 30th July 2021 every day 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police
 - anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Hilldown Road and Fontaine Road or reverse to normal route of travel.
