ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A2213 GLA ROAD (KIDBROOKE PARK ROAD, ROYAL BOROUGH OF GREENWICH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable highway improvement and resurfacing works to take place on the A2213 Kidbrooke Park Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering, exiting or proceeding on the slip roads between A2213 Kidbrooke Park Road and A2 Rochester Way Relief Road;
 - (2) entering, exiting or proceeding on Kidbrooke Park Road between its junctions Old Post Office Lane and the access road to the Superstore at No. 241 Kidbrooke Park Road.

The Order will be effective between 10:00 PM on 20th July 2021 and 5:00 AM on 20th October 2021 every night 10:00 PM to 5:00 AM or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via A2 Rochester Way Relief Road southbound, exit slip to A205, Westthorne Avenue south-westbound and Eltham Road to normal route of travel. Or Rochester Relief Road northbound, A2 exit slip to Sun in the Sands Roundabout, southbound on slip to A2 Rochester Way Relief Road southbound to route above. For Kidbrooke Park Road southbound via Kidbrooke Way, Rochester Way, Well Hall Roundabout, Westthorne Avenue and Eltham Road to normal route of travel. For Kidbrooke Park Road northbound via Eltham Road, Lee Road, Blackheath Village, Montpelier Row, Prince Charles Road and Shooters Hill Road to normal route of travel.
