## **Transport for London Notice**

## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

THE A3220 GLA ROAD (WARWICK ROAD, ROYAL BOROUGH OF KENSINGTON AND CHELSEA) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2021

- 1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable London Underground Limited works to take place near A3220 Warwick Road. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle except those

vehicles being used in connection with London Underground Limited rail replacement bus services from: (1) stopping at the western kerb-line of A3220 Warwick Road

between its junctions with Kempsford Gardens and a point

- opposite the extended common boundary of Nos. 36 and 38 Warwick Road: (2) stopping in the Loading Bay outside Nos. 31 - 33 A3220 Warwick
- Road:
- (3) stopping in the Loading Bay adjacent to Langham Mansions on A3220 Warwick Road.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 12:01 AM on 31st July 2021 until 11:59 PM on 1st August 2021 and from 12:01 AM on 7th August 2021 until 11:59PM on 8th August 2021 or when those works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 3. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
