ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A205 GLA ROAD (WOOLWICH NEW ROAD/GRAND DEPOT ROAD/JOHN WILSON STREET, ROYAL BOROUGH OF GREENWICH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

1. Transport for London in consultation with the Royal Borough of Greenwich hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable highway improvement and resurfacing works to take place on the A205 Woolwich New Road/Grand Depot Road/John Wilson Street.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering, exiting or proceeding on the A205 Woolwich New Road/Grand Depot Road/John Wilson Street between its junctions with Ha Ha Road/Nightingale Place and Wellington Street/ Artillery Place, local access will be maintained southbound between Wellington Street and Grand Depot Road;
 - (2) entering or proceeding on Woolwich New Road southbound between its junctions with Sandy Hill Road and the A205 except for local access.

The Order will be effective between 9:00 PM on 16th July 2021 and 5:00 AM on 16th October 2021 every night 9:00 PM to 5:00 AM or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Woolwich High Street, Woolwich Church Street, Woolwich Road, Blackwall Tunnel Southern Approach, Sun-in-the-Sands roundabout, Shooters Hill Road and Academy Road or reverse to normal route of travel.
