ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES LEIGHAM COURT ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable crane operation works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, have made an order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that section of Leigham Court Road between Nos. 10 and 18 Leigham Court Road.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via Leigham Court Road, Streatham High Road, Streatham Common North, Leigham Court Road & vice versa.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs. It is anticipated that not all roads will be closed at the same time and some of the works will be carried out overnight.

4. The Order will come into force on 1st November 2021 and will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect between 1st November 2021 and 20th November 2021, overnight between 9pm and 5am, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order will also have effect on subsequent dates.
