## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES LEIGHAM COURT ROAD

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable crane operation works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from

entering that section of Leigham Court Road between Nos.

 and 18 Leigham Court Road.
 Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Leigham Court Road, Streatham High Road, Streatham Common North, Leigham Court Road & vice versa.

The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs. It is anticipated that not all roads would be closed at the same time and some of the works would be carried out overnight.
 The Order would come into force on 1st November 2021

and would continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect between 1st November 2021 and 20th November 2021, overnight between 9pm and 5am, but if the works cannot be

completed or carried out during that time the order would also have effect on subsequent dates.
