

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO PARKING PLACES,
WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS IN
HATFIELDS

[NOTE: This Notice is about proposals to amend the layout of parking bays, waiting and loading restrictions on Hatfields near its junction with The Cut. Shared use and disabled persons parking places on the west side would be removed and replaced with "at any time" waiting and loading restrictions. The existing shared use bays on the west side near Isabella Street would be extended and the business / pay by phone parking bay would be changed to a shared use permit holders bay. Objections or other comments may be made – see paragraph 5.]

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth proposes to make the Lambeth (Waterloo "W") (Parking Places) (No. -) Order 202-, the Lambeth (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. -) Order 202-, the Lambeth (Loading Place) (No. -) Order 202-, the Lambeth (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No. -) Order 202-, under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Orders would be, in Hatfields to:-

- (a) remove the existing shared use parking place and disabled persons' parking place on the west side of Hatfields outside Nos. 1 to 10 Benson House and replace with "at any time" waiting and loading restrictions;
- (b) reduce the existing loading bay on the west side of Hatfields outside unit Nos. 2 to 3 Benson House and replace with "at any time" waiting and loading restrictions;
- (c) extend the existing shared use parking places on the west side of Hatfields outside Nos. 11 to 20 Benson House so that they would be one continuous parking place; and
- (d) amend the type of permit holders parking place on the west side of Hatfields north of Isabella Street from business permit and pay by phone to shared use permit holders and pay by phone.
