ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A202 GLA ROAD (VAUXHALL BRIDGE ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable traffic signal works to take place on the A202 Vauxhall Bridge Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering or proceeding into Vauxhall Bridge Road from Chapter Street.
 The Order will be effective at certain times between 8:00 PM on 2nd November 2021 until 5:00 AM on 3rd November 2021 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibition will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via: (Left turn into Douglas Street, left turn into Regency Street, right turn into Causton Street, left turn into Cureton Street, right turn into John Islip Street, Right/left turn into Vauxhall Bridge Road).
