ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3200 GLA ROAD (YORK ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

- Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Lambeth hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable footbridge removal works to take place on the A3220 York Road.
 The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - with Mepham Street and Westminster Bridge Road, local access will be maintained between Westminster Bridge Road and Chicheley Street; (2) entering, exiting or proceeding on Addington Street between its

(I) entering, exiting or proceeding on York Road between its junctions

- junctions with Westminster Bridge Road and York Road, local access will be maintained;

 (3) entering or proceeding on Station Approach between its junctions
- with Holmes Terrace and York Road.

 Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at certain times.

 The Order will be effective at certain times between 5th November

2021 and 29th November 2021, every Friday at 9:00 PM until Monday at 5:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:(1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs. For York Road south via Waterloo Road, St George's Circus, London Road, Garden Row, St George's Road and Westminster Bridge Road to normal route of travel. For York Road north via Westminster Bridge Road, Baylis Road and Waterloo Road to normal route of travel.
