BOAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES ALASKA STREET AND WINDMILL WALK

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable railway bridge maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles
- from enterina: (a) Alaska Street; and
 - (b)that section of Windmill Walk, between the northwestern kerb-line of Wootton Street and the southeastern kerb-line of Brad Street.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Alaska Street, Cornwall Road, Exton Street, Waterloo Road and vice versa. An alternative route for the Windmill Walk closure, as described in 1(b) above, would
- not be required. 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs. It is anticipated that not all roads
- would be closed at the same time. 4. The Order would come into force on 22nd November 2021 and would continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect between 22nd November 2021 and 22nd February 2022 overnight

between 10pm and 6am, but if the works cannot be

completed or carried out during that time the order would also have effect on subsequent dates. Dated 12th November 2021
