2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be

available via Salter's Hill, Central Hill, Elder Road, Gipsy Road, Salter's Hill and vice versa. 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the

4. The Order would come into force on 7th December 2021

and would continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect between 7th December 2021 and 8th December 2021 overnight between 10pm and 6am, but if the works cannot be
