### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

#### **TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE VAUXHALL WALK**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable construction works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily:

- (a) suspend the existing parking place in Vauxhall Walk, the east side, outside No. 87 Vauxhall Walk and ban vehicles from parking and waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle) in this location on Mondays to Fridays between 8am and 6:30pm and on Saturdays between 8am and 1pm; and
- (b) ban pedestrians and vehicles from entering that section of the western footway in Vauxhall Walk, between the southern kerb-line of Tinworth Street and approximately 30 metres south of that kerb-line; and
- (c) ban pedestrians and vehicles from entering that section of the southern footway in Tinworth Street, between the western kerb-line of Vauxhall Walk and approximately 40 metres west of that kerb-line.

2. Alternative routes for affected pedestrians and vehicles would be available via the eastern footway in Vauxhall Walk and the northern footway in Tinworth Street.

3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 3rd December 2021 and would continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier.
