NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM

- 1. (1) Road closure at any time and no parking/waiting between 7am and 7pm Monday to Friday, in Scawen Road, SE8, between the projected common boundary of Nos.31/32 Scawen Road and the projected common boundary of Nos.38/39 Scawen Road. (2) The diversion routes for traffic affected by the prohibition are via Crooke Road, Alloa Road, Trundleys Road and Kezia Street, and vice versa.
- 2. Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.
 - 3. The order comes into force on the 29th November 2021 to remain in force for up to 10 months. (Note: Parking/waiting will be in force as and when required to service the site and short road closures may be used for planned utility connection
- works if required.)
 4. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
