ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A20 GLA SIDE ROAD (CRATHIE ROAD, ROYAL BOROUGH OF GREENWICH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2021

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable traffic signal works to take place on the A20 GLA Side Road Crathie Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping at any time in the parking and disabled persons' parking bays on the A20 GLA Side Road Crathie Road, near its junction with Eltham Road. The Order will be effective between 7:00 AM on 14th November 2021 until 5.00 PM on 23rd January 2022 or until the works has been

completed. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibition will not apply in respect of:
 (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire
 - brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
