ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3 GLA SIDE ROAD (STOCKWELL PARK ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2021

- 1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the abovenamed Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable Thames Water works to take place on the A3 GLA Side Road, Stockwell Park Road,
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (I) exiting the westbound carriageway of Stockwell Park Road onto the A3 Clapham Road:
 - (2) stopping in the Parking Bay on Stockwell Park Road at the side of No.169 Clapham Road. The Order will be effective at certain times from 8:00 AM on the 20th

November 2021 until 5:00 PM on the 20th November 2021 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Groveway, Brixton Road, Hillyard Street and Durand Gardens to normal route of travel.
