

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE BONDWAY

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable telecommunication works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Bondway which lies between Parry Street and approximately 11 metres south of Parry Street.
2. An alternative route for vehicles will be available via Parry Street and Wandsworth Road.
3. The ban on vehicles entering Bondway will not apply to any vehicle requiring access to or egress from properties or premises in Bondway or Miles Street, accessible only from Bondway, providing that vehicle does not interfere with or disrupt the works.
4. The above road closure will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
5. The Order will come into force on 5th January 2022 and it will continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect from 5th January 2022 for 2 days, but if the works cannot be carried out or be completed during that time then the Order may have effect on a subsequent day or days within the maximum duration of 2 months.
