

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE HACKFORD ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable gas repair and maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that section of Hackford Road, between Nos. 37 to 54 Hackford Road.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Hackford Road, Mowll Street, Brixton Road, South Island Place, Hackford Road and vice versa.

3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs. It is anticipated that not all roads would be closed at the same time.

4. The Order would come into force on 10th January 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect between 10th January 2022 and 14th January 2022, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order would also have effect on subsequent dates.
