

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES HARPENDEN ROAD
& ULLSWATER ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water repair and maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily:

- (a) ban vehicles from entering that section of Harpenden Road between Nos. 66 and 77 Harpenden Road;
- (b) ban vehicles from entering that section of Ullswater Road between No. 21 Ullswater Road and its junction with Harpenden Road; and
- (c) ban pedestrians and vehicles from entering that section of the south-western footway of Harpenden Road between Nos. 66 to 77 Harpenden Road.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via Harpenden Road, York Hill, Norwood Road, Ullswater Road, Ulverstone Road, Harpenden Road and vice versa.

3. Alternative routes for affected pedestrians will be via the north-eastern footway of Harpenden Road.

4. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

5. The Order will come into force on 6th December 2021 and will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect between 6th December 2021 and 10th December 2021, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order will also have effect on subsequent dates.
