maintenance and repair works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Rothschild Street

which lies between Norwood High Street and a point 30 metres west of Norwood High Street. 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via (i) Norwood High Street, Chapel Road and

Knight's Hill and Vice versa; and (ii) Norwood High Street,

Ernest Avenue and Knight's Hill. 3. The road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs. 4. The Order would come into force on 11th January 2022 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month

(to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect on 11th January 2022, but if the works cannot be carried out or be completed during that time then the Order may have effect on a subsequent day or days within the maximum duration

of 1 month.
