ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE VALENTIA PLACE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Network Rail bridge examination works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that section of Valentia Place which lies between the southern kerb-line of Brixton Station Road and Nos. 1 -7 Valentia Place.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via (i) Valentia Place, Coldharbour Lane, Gresham Road, Wiltshire Road, Canterbury Crescent, Pope's Road, Brixton Station Road and Valentia Place; and (ii) Valentia Place, Brixton Station Road, Barrington Road, Coldharbour Lane and Valentia Place.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 10th December 2021 and will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect between 10th December 2021 and 11th December 2021 overnight between 10pm and 6am, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order will also have effect on subsequent dates.
