NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of Network Rail bridge works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

 (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in Rolt Street, between Childers Street and Trundleys Road. (2) The alternative routes for traffic affected by the prohibition are via Rolt Street, Trundleys Road, Sanford Street, Edward Street, Arklow Road and Childers Street, and vice versa.

Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.

3. The order comes into force on the 7th January 2022 to remain in force for up to 2 months.

(Note: These are night works are planned for 7th and 8th January 2022.)

The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
