ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A203 GLA ROAD (SOUTH LAMBETH PLACE, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2022

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable Network Rail survey works to take place on South Lambeth Place.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering, proceeding or stopping on South Lambeth Place between its junctions with South Lambeth Road and Bondway.
The Order will be effective from 10:00 PM on 9th January 2022 until 6:00 AM on 10th January 2022 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via: South Lambeth Road, Parry Street and South Lambeth Place and then onto normal route of travel.
