ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A203 GLA ROAD (STOCKWELL ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable Thames Water works to take place on Brixton Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering, exiting or proceeding in the south-eastbound contra-flow bus lane on Stockwell Road between its junctions with Stockwell Park Walk and Brixton Road. Local access will be maintained.

The Order will be effective from 7:00 AM on 27th December 2021 until 7:00 PM on 31st December 2021 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Stockwell Road and Stockwell Park Walk back to normal route of travel.
