ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A100 GLA ROAD (TOWER BRIDGE, LONDON BOROUGHES OF SOUTHWARK AND TOWER HAMLETS) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) (No.2) ORDER 2021

1. Transport for London in consultation with the City of London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable highway improvement and resurfacing works to take place on the A100 Tower Bridge Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on the A100 Tower Bridge Approach/ Tower Bridge/ Tower Bridge Road between its junctions with Queen Elizabeth Street and East Smithfield;
 - (2) entering or proceeding on Tower Bridge Road northbound between its junction with Bricklayer's Arms Roundabout and Queen Elizabeth Street, except local access;
 - (3) entering or proceeding on Queen Elizabeth Street eastbound between its junctions with Tooley Street and Tower Bridge Road.

Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at certain times.

The Order will be effective at certain times between 7:00 AM on 4th December 2021 until 3:00 AM on 6th December 2021 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Tower Hill, Byward Street, Lower Thames Street, Upper Thames Street, Queen Street Place, Southwark Bridge, Southwark Bridge Road, Marshalsea Road, Great Dover Street, Bricklayer's Arms and Tower Bridge Road or reverse to normal route of travel.
