ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE WORGAN STREET

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water service connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles and pedestrians from entering that section of Worgan Street, including the western footway, which lies between the northern boundary of Nos. 20 and 22 Spring House, Worgan Street and the southern boundary of No. 24 Worgan Street.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via (i) Worgan Street, Jonathan Street, Vauxhall Walk, Glasshouse Walk and Worgan Street; and (ii) Worgan Street, Glasshouse Walk, Tyers Street, Jonathan Street and Worgan Street.

3. Alternative routes for affected pedestrians will be available via the eastern footway of Worgan Street.

4. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

5. The Order will come into force on 24th January 2022 and will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect between 24th January 2022 and 28th January 2022, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order will also have effect on subsequent dates.
