**The Lewisham (Prescribed Routes) (No. \*) Traffic**  
**Order 2022**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lewisham propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Order would be to prohibit goods vehicles (exceeding a maximum gross weight of 7.5 tonnes) from entering or proceeding in both directions of:

(a) Avignon Road, between Drakefell Road and St Asaph Road;

(b) Alpha Road between New Cross Road and Florence Road;

(c) Florence Road between Heald Street and Lewisham Way;

3.
