

# LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM

## Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

### The Lewisham (Phoebeth Road and Chudleigh Road, SE4)

### (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2022

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lewisham Council made this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of Thames water works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

**1.** (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in (i) Phoebeth Road from Chudleigh Road to a point 25meters northwards, and (ii) Chudleigh Road between the boundaries of 47/49 and 55/57 Chudleigh Road. (2) The alternative routes for traffic affected by the prohibition are (i) Phoebeth Road, Ladywell Road and Francemary Road, and vice versa; and (ii) Chudleigh Road, Ladywell Road, Francemary Road and Chudleigh Road, and vice versa.

**2.** Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.

**3.** The order comes into force on the 25th January 2022 to remain in force for up to 3 months.

*(Note: Works are expected to be completed between 12th and 20th February 2022)*

**4.** The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
