ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A200 GLA ROAD (BERMONDSEY STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

- Transport for London in consultation hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable rail bridge inspection works to take place on the A200 Bermondsey Street.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering or proceeding on Bermondsey Street between its junctions with Crucifix Lane and Magdalen Street, except pedal cycles.
 The Order will be effective at certain times from 10:00 PM on 23rd January 2022 and 6:00 AM on 24th January 2022 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to
- time be indicated by traffic signs.

 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via St Thomas Street, Borough High Street, Duke Street Hill and Tooley Street to normal route of travel.
