

Transport for London Notice

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3 GLA SIDE ROAD (LONDON BRIDGE STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY BANNED TURN) ORDER 2022

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable carriageway repair works to take place on the A3 Borough High Street.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from turning right from London Bridge Street into Borough High Street northbound. The Order permits all vehicles to turn right from Southwark Bridge Road northbound into Southwark Street eastbound. The Order will be effective at certain times from 9:00 PM on 28th January 2022 and 5:00 AM on 29th January 2022 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Borough High Street southbound, Marshalsea Road, Southwark Bridge Road, Southwark Street and Borough High Street to normal route of travel.
