ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES AND ONE WAY WORKINGS BELVEDERE ROAD AND CHICHELEY STREET

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable construction works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an order the effect of which will

- be to temporarily restrict and prohibit traffic as follows:

 (a) during stage 1 (not all bans described below will be in effect at the same time):
 - (i) in Belvedere Road,
 - (A) ban vehicles from entering that section which lies between the south-western kerb-line of Concert Hall Approach and the north-eastern kerb-line of
 - Chicheley Street;
 (B) ban vehicles from entering at the junction with the south-western kerb-line of
 - Concert Hall Approach; and

 (C) ban vehicles travelling in a southerly direction, between the south-western kerb-line of Concert Hall Approach and the north-eastern kerb-line of
 - Chicheley Street;
 (ii) in Chicheley Street:
 - (A) ban vehicles from entering the entire length of street:
 - (B) ban vehicles from entering the entire length of street,
 - (C) ban vehicles from travelling in a south-easterly direction; and
 - (D) ban vehicles from entering at the junction with Belvedere Road: and
 - (b) during stage 2, phases 6 8:
 -) ban vehicles from entering Chichelev Street: and
 - (i) ban vehicles from entering **Chicheley Street**; and
 (ii) ban vehicles from entering **Belvedere Road**, between the south-western kerb-
 - line of Concert Hall Approach and the north-eastern kerb-line of Chicheley Street; and
 - (iii) ban vehicles from entering the access to County Hall and the County Hall Apartments.
 - Apartments.
- 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via York Road, Concert Hall Approach, Tenison Way, Waterloo Road and vice versa.
- The bans will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
 The Order will come into force on 28th February 2022 and will continue for a maximum
- duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect between 28th February 2022 and 27th May 2022, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order will also have effect on subsequent dates. It is also anticipated that not all phases and bans will be in effect at any same time and access to properties will be maintained where possible during the works.
