TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - BURTON ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames

Water repair and maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, in agreement with Transport for London, have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering Burton Road, between the eastern kerb-line of Brixton

Road and its eastern extremity.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles are not required and access will be maintained.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent

as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 8th February 2022 and will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is

allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect on 8th February 2022 until 9th February 2002, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the

order will also have effect on subsequent dates.
