## LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14** TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE CHEVIOT ROAD

## 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames

Water repair and maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, in agreement with Transport for London, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles and

pedestrians from entering that section of Cheviot Road, including the south-eastern footway, which lies between the northern boundary of No. 132 Knights Hill and the northeastern boundary of No. 1A Cheviot Road.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Cheviot Road, Roxburgh Road, Bewlys Road, Knight's Hill. Cheviot Road and vice versa. 3. Alternative routes for affected pedestrians would be

available via the north-western footway of Cheviot Road. 4. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

The Order would come into force on 28th February 2022

and would continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect between

28th February 2022 and 4th March 2022, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order would also have effect on subsequent dates.
