## BAN ON WAITING VEHICLES AND AMENDMENTS TO PARKING PLACES

[NOTE: This Notice is about the introduction and amendment of waiting restrictions in

Coldharbour Lane, Dulwich Road and Effra Road, and amendment to parking places on

Dulwich Road and Effra Road. 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth on 16th February 2022 have made the Lambeth (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (No. 306)

Order 2022, the Lambeth (Brixton "B") (Parking Places) (No. 2) Order 2022 and the

- Lambeth (Poets Corner "P") (Parking Places) (No. 2) Order 2022, under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Orders will be to:-
- (a) in Coldharbour Lane, introduce double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions on the south-east side, between a point 3.4 metres south-west of a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 348 and 350 and a point 10 metres north-east of the northeastern kerb-line of Somerlevton Road:
- (b) in Dulwich Road, remove 37 metres of existing parking place on the south-west side, between a point opposite its junction with Rymer Street and a point opposite No. 129 Dulwich Road, and provide 43 metres of parking place opposite Nos. 101
- to 115 Dulwich Road; and (c) in Effra Road, provide double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions on the west side, between the southern kerb-line of Crownstone Road and a point opposite No. 83 Effra Road, and remove 23 metres of existing parking place opposite Nos.
- 73 to 81 Effra Road. 3. The Orders are necessary to implement bus priority improvement measures by providing additional bus stops in Effra Road and Knight's Hill, relocate an existing bus stand in Dulwich Road and provide yellow box markings in Coldharbour Lane at its junctions with Shakespeare Road and Valentia Place, and Loughborough Road at its junction with Minet Road. These proposals also amend existing waiting restrictions and
- parking places so as to improve access and movement of traffic flow. 4. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under

that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on
