

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – COTTAGE GROVE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable crane operation works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, in agreement with Transport for London, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering Cottage Grove between the eastern kerb-line of Bedford Road and No. 46 Cottage Grove.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via (i) Bedford Road, Clapham High Street, Clapham Road, Mayflower Road, Tregothnan Road, Prideaux Road, Landor Road, Willington Road and Cottage Grove; and (ii) Cottage Grove, Willington Road, Landor Road, Bedford Road and Cottage Grove.

3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 24th February 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect on 24th February 2022 until 22nd March 2002, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order would also have effect on subsequent dates.
