

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD AND FOOTWAY CLOSURE –
CRESCENT LANE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable BT to carry out repair and maintenance works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban –

- (a) vehicles from entering in that length of Crescent Lane, which lies between Park Hill and a point 10 metres east of Park Hill;
- (b) pedestrians from entering in that length of the northern footway of Crescent Lane specified in the sub-paragraph 1(a) above. An alternative route would be available via the southern footway of Crescent Lane;
- (c) pedestrians from entering in that length of the eastern footway of Park Hill which lies between Crescent Lane and the party wall of Nos. 121 and 119 Park Hill. An alternative route would be available via the western footway of Park Hill.

2. The above road and footway closures would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. No alternative routes would be available for affected motor vehicles, however pedal cyclists would be required to dismount and use the alternative routes specified in sub-paragraph 1(b) and 1(c) above.

4. Access for emergency service vehicles and residents will be maintained using road plates when safe to do so.

5. The Order would come into force on 23rd February 2022 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 6 months, or until the works have been completed, whichever is earlier. In practice, it is anticipated that the road closure would only apply for 3 days.
