ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CRICKLADE AVENUE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable maintenance and repair works to be carried out by Thames Water, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Cricklade Avenue, which lies between the party wall of Nos. 125 and 127 Cricklade Avenue and the party wall of Nos. 131 and 133 Cricklade Avenue.

2. An alternative route will be available for affected vehicles via Cricklade Avenue, Faygate Road, Barcombe Avenue, Hillside Road and Cricklade Avenue and vice versa.

3. The road closure will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 9th March 2022 and will continue for a maximum duration of 6 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works will be carried out between 9th March 2022 and 14th March 2022, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 6 months.
