LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14** TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF EARDLEY ROAD FOR RAILWAY BRIDGE WORKS

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable railway bridge inspection works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, subject to the

agreement of Wandsworth Council, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban

vehicles from entering that length of Eardley Road, which lies between Edgington Road and Beslev Street.

2. An alternative route would be available for affected vehicles via (a) Mitcham Lane, Streatham Road, London Road, Upper Green West, Upper Green East, Commonside

West, Commonside East, Manor Road, Rowan Road, Greyhound Terrace, Streatham Vale, Aberfoyle Road, Carnforth Road and Eardley Road; and (b) Eardley Road, Greyhound Lane, Streatham High Road, Gleneagle Road, Ambleside Avenue, Mitcham Lane and Eardley Road. 3. The road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the

appropriate traffic signs. The Order would come into force on 3rd March 2022 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be carried out overnight on 3rd March and 4th March 2022, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect at a subsequent
