1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water repair and maintenance works to be carried out, the

Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, in agreement with Transport for London, have made an order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that section of Leigham Court Road which lies between

the southeastern kerb-line of Romeyn Road and the common boundary of Nos. 137 and 139 Leigham Court Road. 2 Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available.

via (i) Leigham Court Road, Streatham High Road, Streatham Common North, Valley Road and Leigham Court Road: and (ii) Leigham Court Road, Valley Road. Streatham Common North, Streatham High Road, Drewstead Road, Railway Bridge, Sternhold Avenue, Streatham High Road and Leigham Court Road.

The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs. The Order will come into force on 15th February 2022 and will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect between

15th February 2022 and 16th February 2022 overnight

between 9pm and 6am, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order will also have effect on subsequent dates. Dated 11th February 2022
