- London Borough of Lambeth proposes to make the Lambeth (Kennington) (Parking Places) (No. -) Order 2022 and the Lambeth (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. -) Order 2022, under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- The general effect of the Orders would be, in Montford Place, to:—
 (a) remove 6.9 metres of shared use parking place on
 - the west side located 37.4 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Kennington Lane and replace this section with double yellow line "at any time" waiting and restrictions; and
 - (b) upgrade 39.2 metres of single yellow line waiting restrictions on the east side, outside No. 20 Montford Place, to double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions.

The proposed Orders are necessary to accommodate a new vehicle crossover on the west side of Montford Place

- as part of the development of "Oval Village" and prevent obstruction of access and disabled parking bays on the east side of Montford Place associated with No. 20 Montford Place.
