### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

#### **TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE PLATO ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water cover replacement works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, in agreement with Transport for London, have made an order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering Plato Road at its junction with Acre Lane. Access to Plato Road will be maintained for residents and businesses.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via (i) Kepler Road, Hetherington Road, Acre Lane and vice versa; and (ii) Kepler Road, Solon Road, Acre Lane and vice versa.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 15th February 2022 and will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect between 15th February 2022 and 16th February 2022 overnight between 9pm and 6am, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order will also have effect on subsequent dates.
