ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - SUNNYHILL ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable utility works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, in agreement with Transport for London, have made an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering Sunnyhill Road, between the eastern kerb-line of Farm Avenue and the western kerb-line of Valley Road.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via (i) Sunnyhill Road, Farm Avenue, Angles Road and vice versa, and (ii) Sunnyhill Road, Wellfield Road, Valley Road and vice versa.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 7th February 2022 and will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect on 7th February 2022 until 29th May 2002, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order will also have effect on subsequent dates.
