ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - UPPER MARSH

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Network Rail bridge works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, in agreement with Transport for London, have made an Order, the effect of which will be to continue to temporarily:

- (a) ban vehicles from entering that section of Upper Marsh, which lies between the south-western kerb-line of Westminster Bridge Road and the eastern kerb-line of the access road leading to the Enterprise car and van hire site on Upper Marsh; and
- (b) suspend the one way working on Upper Marsh between the northern kerb-line of Royal Street and a point 18 metres north-east of the eastern kerb-line of the access road leading to the Enterprise car and van hire site on Upper Marsh.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via Upper Marsh, Royal Street, Centaur Street, Hercules Road, Kennington Road and Westminster Bridge Road.

3. The ban and suspension will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 4th February 2022 and will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier (the ban has been in force from 31st January to 4th February 2022 inclusive by virtue of a notice issued under section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
