amended. 2. The general effect of the Order will be to:

(a) introduce one-way eastbound working in: (i) Rayford Avenue, at its junction with Waite Davies Road and Ronver Road; and

(c) prohibit vehicles from turning right:

(d) prohibit vehicles from turning left:

(ii) Whitburn Road, at its junction with Lewisham High Street and Courthill Road;

(b) prohibit vehicles from entering:

(i) Doggett Road, south of its junction with Holbeach; (ii) Manor Mount, at its junction with Honor Oak Road:

(iii) Marnock Road, at its junction with Brockley Road;

(iv) Rayford Avenue, at its junction with Waite Davies Road and Ronver Road; (v) Whitburn Road, at its junction with Lewisham High Street and Courthill Road; and

(vi) Wildfell Road, at its junction with Brookdale Road and Morena Street;

(i) from Lewisham High Street (southbound) into Whitburn Road, except pedal cycles: (ii) from Morena Street (north-westbound) into Brookdale Road and Wildfell Road; and

(iii) from Whitburn Road (eastbound) into Lewisham High Street, except pedal cycles; and (i) from Brookdale Road (southbound) into Wildfell Road;

(ii) from Lewisham High Street (southbound) into Courthill Road, except pedal cycles; (iii) from Lewisham High Street (northbound) into Whitburn Road; and

(iv) from Whitburn Road (eastbound) into Lewisham High Street, except pedal cycles.
