## The Lewisham (St. Norbert Road, SE4) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2022 NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made this temporary

traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of Network Rail works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

- 1. (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in St. Norbert Road, SE4 between Brockill Crescent and the access road to Pulton House. St. Norbert Road, (2) The alternative routes for traffic affected by the prohibition are via Brockill Crescent, Revelon Road, Frendsbury Road and St. Norbert Road, and vice versa.
- 2. Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.
- 3. The order comes into force on the 18th February 2022 to remain in force
- for up to 2 months.
- (Note: Works are expected to be completed on 18th and 19th February 2022) The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
