NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A PREMISES LICENCE -LICENSING ACT 2003

Notice is given that: Ms Christina Reynolds for and on behalf of the Greenwich Cooperative Development Agency (of charitable status) has applied for the Grant of a Premises Licence for the following premises / site:

An area incorporating Dial Arch Square (lawns); No.1 Street from the Woolwich Royal Arsenal entrance gates to just beyond the site of the former Firepower Museum; Duke of Wellington Avenue (West); and Artillery Square, London SE18.

A record of this application may be inspected by appointment. Other persons may make representations to the Council on this application by no later than Tuesday 1st March 2022. Representations can be made in writing, by email or fax using the contact details above. Representations can only be made on the grounds of one of the four licensing objectives, namely:

- Prevention of Crime and Disorder Prevention of Public Nuisance
- Public Safety
- Protection of Children from Harm

Any person who makes a false statement in connection with an application is liable on summary conviction to an unlimited fine. It is proposed that the following licensable activities will take place at the premises / site on the basis of no more than SIX one-dav events annually:

Plays, Films, Live & Recorded Music, Dance, Anything Similar to Music & Dance (e.g. spoken word, walkabout entertainers), and the On & Off-Sale of Alcohol, between 10:00 hours and 21:00 hours daily. Each of the six one-day events will usually be held on a Friday. Saturday or Sunday, but "daily" is being applied for to allow flexibility. Off-sales of alcohol are to be taken away from Royal Arsenal or into homes if purchased by local residents: there is to be no openair consumption.
