ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A24 AND A214 GLA ROADS (TOOTING BEC JUNCTION, LONDON BOROUGH OF WANDSWORTH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2022

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable signal modernisation works to take place at the junction on the A24 Balham High Road/ Upper Tooting Road and A214 Trinity Road/ Tooting Bec Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:(1) stopping in the Loading and Disabled Persons Vehicle bay on Dafforne Road at the side of No.15 Upper Tooting Road;
 - (2) stopping in the Loading and Disabled Persons Vehicle bay on Tooting Bec Road at the side of No.313 Balham High Road.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 7:00 AM on 21st February 2022 and 5:00 PM on 30th March 2022 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will

- apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
