ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A24 GLA ROAD (TOOTING HIGH STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF WANDSWORTH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2022

1. Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Wandsworth hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable highway improvement and resurfacing works to take place on the A24 Tooting High Street.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on the Tooting High Street between its junctions with Hoyle Road and Salkirk Road;
 - (2) entering or proceeding on A24 Upper Tooting Road/ Tooting High Street southbound between its junctions with Trinity Road/ Tooting Bec Road and Salkirk Road, local access will be maintained;
 - (3) entering or proceeding on A24 High Street Colliers Wood/ Tooting Road High Street northbound between its junctions with Priory Road and Hoyle Road, local access will be maintained;
 - (4) entering, proceeding or stopping on Mitcham Road between Longmead Road and Tooting High Street;
 - (5) entering or proceeding on A217 London Road/ Mitcham Road northbound between its junctions with Streatham Road and Longmead Road, local access will be maintained;
 - (6) entering or proceeding on Garratt Lane between its junctions with Tooting High Street and Nos.1079 and 1081 Garratt Lane;
 - (7) stopping on Garratt Lane between its junctions with Tooting High Street and Nos.1079 and 1081 Garratt Lane;
 - (8) entering or proceeding on Garratt Lane eastbound between its junctions with Summerstown and Nos.1079 and 1081 Garratt Lane, local access will be maintained;

The Order will also:

- (9) permit two-way operation on Garratt Terrace between its junctions with Tooting High Street and Garratt Lane.

Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at certain times.

The Order will be effective at certain times between 21st February 2022 and 16th April 2022, every night 9:00 PM until 6:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs. For A24 southbound via Tooting Bec Road, Tooting Bec Gardens, Mitcham Lane, Streatham Road, London Road, Holborn Way, Western Road, Christchurch Road, Merantun Way to normal route of travel. For A24 northbound via Merantun Way, Christchurch Road, Western Road, Holborn Way, London Road, Streatham Road, Mitcham Lane, Ambleside Avenue and Tooting Bec Road to normal route of travel.
