- maintenance works by GEM Environmental Building Services Ltd to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, subject to the agreement of Transport for London, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily:
 - which lies between Brixton Hill and the un-named access road situated adjacent to No.2 Hayter Road, in an easterly direction (towards Beverstone Road);

 (b) han the left turn by vehicles from the un-named

(a) impose a one-way traffic system in Hayter Road.

- (b) ban the left turn by vehicles from the un-named access road adjacent to No. 2 Hayter Road into Hayter Road.
- An alternative route would be available for vehicles affected by the bans described in paragraph 1 above via Beverstone Road, Sudbourne Road and Brixton Hill and vice versa.
- The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 4th April 2022 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the bans would only apply for 5 days but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have

effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of
