Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984
The Lewisham (Bertrand Street, SE13)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2022.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made the above named temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of Network Rail bridge works on and adjacent to the highway in Loampit Vale, SE13. The effects of the order are indicated below.

1. (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in Bertrand Street, SE13, between a point 7 meters east of the projected eastern kerbline of Branscombe Street and the eastern extents of Bertrand Street. (2) There are no alternative routes for traffic affected by the prohibition as this section of Bertrand Street is a cul-sac-sac.

(Note; Access shall be maintained for pedestrian and cycles, and the adjacent disabled bays shall be relocated as near to their original location as practicable.)

2. Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.

3. The order comes into force on the 25th March 2022 to remain in force for up to 8 months.

(Note: Works are planned to completed by the end of September 2022)

4. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
